PROSPECTUS

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all OPS Members who have an up-to-date 2020 paid membership with Ozark Pastel Society. (Individuals who are not current OPS Members, but wishing to participate in this exhibit, may pay the \$15 dues fees (discount amount for all Members in 2021) by September 15 to participate. If paid by September 15, these fees will be applied to your 2021 OPS Membership.)

ENTRY DEADLINE: Digital image(s) of your work to be shown in the exhibit must be submitted to Margi Tucker (angellight7777@yahoo.com) by no later than September 15, 2020.

ELIGIBLE WORK: Your work must meet the following criteria –

- Maximum of three (3) images are permitted in the exhibit.
- Works must be in dry pastel with final surface a minimum of 80% pastel. No oil pastels.
- Works must be original and not created on top of a base photo or print.
- Works may be created from your own photographs or from copyright free photographs.
(Because this is an Exhibit only, and not a Competition, there is some leniency here. If you plan to use someone else's photo, etc. as subject matter; check the copyright and copyright laws for any possible infringements or copyright violations. If you are using a photo reference from someone you know, it is still recommended that you get written permission from them to use it.)
- Works must have been created within the last four (4) years.
- All subjects and styles, from traditional to contemporary are eligible.
- Nudes will be considered but the OPS Board will make the final decision as to whether they will be displayed in the Exhibit..
- Works done under supervision (such as in a workshop or class) are not eligible.

PREPARATION OF IMAGES:

- Only jpeg (or jpg) images will be accepted.
- Images of artwork should NOT include matting (if used) or frame...artwork only.
- Images should be 1200 pixels on the longest side at a resolution of 300 dpi.
- Maximum file size for EACH image submitted is 2 MB.
- Name / save your files as follows. Remove all spaces and special characters in the version of the title you use and save file as last name, underscore, first initial, underscore, title (with no spaces), saved as jpg. For example: Jane Doe's painting My Son's Car becomes:
Doe_J_MySonsCar.jpg
- If you do not have the software to edit your images, or do not know how, you may still enter the show by emailing your images to Margi Tucker (above) and an OPS Board member will do the editing for you.

- Title of painting
- Size of painting, h x w (image only, do not include any matte or frame in the dimensions)
- Artist's name
- Any interesting or pertinent information about the painting that you would like included with the image. Limit information to 50 words maximum.
